Sierra Cantor, Gold Ridge RCD's Ecologist since 2010, has been participating in resource conservation planning and conducting biological and ecological surveys of Sonoma County flora and fauna for over 20 years. She conducts biological surveys, water quality monitoring, synoptic storm sampling, evaluation of riparian revegetation and large wood placement projects, as well as participating in biological surveys for California red-legged frogs and California freshwater shrimp. Having been born, raised, and now raising her own children in western Sonoma County, she has a passionate interest in and commitment to the conservation of the natural and agricultural resources that define the region.
